

One thing recruiters look for is that you show the potential of finding joy in their job. Another thing they look for in a resume is that you show that you learn from the various job experiences that you've had. Here are some examples from resumes: "This opportunity taught me work ethic, responsibility and teamwork . . ." "Learned valuable communications skills in a stressed environment." "I've learned how to handle hard to deal with customers and how to socialize with people in general." Quantify what you have done if possible. "I interacted with 30 customers a day." This is similar to the lab reports where you are to quantify how well the data support a model. This helps make the case that you to be an analytic thinker.
